## Focus

The largest conference in Europe dedicated to R&I policy evaluation invites **submissions of extended abstracts and posters** in four focal thematic areas to share methodological advances in R&I policy evaluation and to debate challenges of assessing the transformative relevance and impact of new R&I policies and their implications for evaluation theory and practice. Contributions do not need to refer to only one thematic area but can be cross-cutting.:

- **Strand 1** concerns all developments that have taken place and on all types of effects of R&I policies.
- **Strand 2** puts a spotlight on the effects of the COVID-19 crisis on R&I policy, in particular on awarding practices.
- In **Strand 3** we ask how to conceptualise and assess the resilience of R&I systems and their contributions to more resilient economies and societies.
- **Strand 4** deals with the nature and the evaluative challenges and practices of transformative oriented R&I policy.

## Re-opening after postponement

The REvaluation Conference was supposed to take place 18-19 November 2021. Due to the drastic severance of the COVID-19 pandemic in Austria at that time, the Conference was postponed to 5-6 May 2022 and a call for new additional contributions was re-opened.

**Those whose extended abstracts have already been selected do not need to resubmit.** Please just let us know if you will physically present your paper in Vienna in May 2022.

## Call for papers and posters

**We strongly encourage academic as well as policy and practice-based submissions.** Thus, contributions from policy-makers, R&I councils, R&I funding agencies, policy experts, intermediary organisations, advanced students and academics are highly appreciated! Papers and posters from **other policy fields** which deal with transformation, sustainability and resilience are explicitly welcomed too!

The conference also encourages contributions with a view on **European perspectives as well as contributions from countries outside Europe.** The **extended abstracts, posters, video or multi-media** contributions will be **reviewed** by the Scientific Committee. The selected contributions are **invited to give a presentation or present their contribution** at the conference.

We also invite to submit a full paper for the conference proceedings, which will be published as a special issue of the 'Journal for Research and Technology Policy Evaluation'. The submission of a full paper, however, is not mandatory and does not affect the presentation.

## Quality criteria

**Submitted abstract and outlines for other contributions** are reviewed by members of the Scientific Committee to ensure that they fit the subject areas<sup>1</sup>. Please concisely inform about

- the object and purpose of the presented policy/measure/evaluation/research;
- the novelty (policy design, approach, methodology); and
- the results (if already available) of your contribution.

## Timeline

- **25 November 2021:** Publication of the call for contributions for the new conference date May 5-6 2022.
- **30 January 2022:** Submission deadline for extended abstracts and outlines for posters or multi-media contributions
- **4 March 2022:** Selection decision and invitation for the submission of full papers and the production of posters or multi-media contributions
- The **conference proceedings** will be published early 2022 as originally planned as a special issue #53 of the fteval Journal for Research and Technology Policy Evaluation. ### For all submissions:

#### MS Word or Open Document Text, including

- Title** (optional: subtitle)
- A short summary** (half-page)
- Author information:**
  - full name
  - institution and address
  - e-mail
  - ORCID, if available
- Author keywords**

#### Indicate your main contribution to the conference strands<sup>2</sup>:

- 1 - Conceptual and methodological advances in R&I policy evaluation
- 2 - What can we learn from fast-track COVID-19 R&I policies?
- 3 - Evaluation of resilience of R&I systems and their contribution to public resilience
- 4 - Understanding and evaluating transformative R&I policy

### AND

#### Extended abstracts:

- 2-4 pages of full text Extended Abstract

#### Other submissions (poster, video, multi-media):

##### First submission:

- 2-4 pages of full text describing the poster (MS Word or Open Document Text)
- optional: a ready-made **draft** of the poster (PDF)
- optional: a ready-made **draft or documentation** of the video or multi-media contribution

##### Final Submissions (once approved):

- Poster:** One page (DIN A0 format) **PDF file** with high resolution images
- Poster:** Please bring your printed<sup>3</sup> Poster to the conference venue. Should you need local printing support, please contact [info@revaluation2021.eu](mailto:info@revaluation2021.eu)
